ORDER FOR INVESTIGATION OF CHILD ABUSE

On this day, the *Petition for Orders in Aid of Investigation of a Report of Child Abuse* filed by the Department of Family and Protective Services ("the Department") was presented to me.

1. Jurisdiction

Having examined the pleadings and reviewed the evidence, the Court finds that it has jurisdiction to render the requested orders under § 261.303, Texas Family Code.

2. Findings

2.1. The Court, having examined the pleadings and affidavit on file, finds that the Department has probable cause to conduct the investigation, and is entitled to orders as requested in its petition, and that there is an immediate need for the Department to have investigatory access to the children's home at YFZ Ranch, Eldorado, TX 76936 and to have investigatory access to the following children:

3.1. **IT IS ORDERED** that a parent or person responsible for the children's care, immediately allow an authorized representative of the Department of Family and Protective Services to enter the home listed above; to interview and examine the

children, which may include medical, psychological or psychiatric examination; and to transport the children for purposes relating to the investigation or interview.

3.2. **IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that the Sheriff of Schleicher County, Texas, serve this order on a parent or person responsible for the children's care and be available to assist in the execution of this Order.

IT IS ORDERED that the foregoing orders shall continue in full force and effect until May 1, 2008, on which date, unless otherwise ordered by this Court, this Cause will be **DISMISSED** and removed by the clerk from the docket, without prejudice.
